Honorable Special District Members, the [Orange County Local Agency Formation Commission](#) (OC LAFCO, the Commission) held in-person meetings on [March 9, April 13, May 11 and June 8, 2022](#). The Commission's next meeting is its (rescheduled) **Strategic Planning Workshop** on Wednesday, July 13, 2022, from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., in the County Administration South (CAS) Multipurpose Room (Room 104), located at 601 N. Ross Street, Santa Ana, CA 92701...the public is welcome. Recent OC LAFCO items relevant to Orange County's independent special districts include:

- **Special District Representatives Selected** – Under Government Code Section 56332, because no other candidates were nominated, [Commissioners Davert and Freshley](#) were deemed selected to retain their positions through June 2026.
- **FY 2022-23 Budget Approved** – OC LAFCO approved a final [budget](#) totaling \$1,556,120, which is \$187,870 (or approximately 13.7%) higher than the Commission's FY 2021-22 budget.
- **4th Cycle MSRs** – Previously scheduled to commence by June 30, 2022, MSR updates for the [Southwest and West MSR Regions](#) are delayed; OC LAFCO has retained Rosenow Specavek Group to complete these by July 2023.
- **OC LAFCO [Future Meetings](#) Locations** – The Commission's regular meeting on Wednesday, August 10, 2022, begins at 8:15 a.m. and will take place at the Hall of Administration, Planning Commission Hearing Room, 333 W. Santa Ana Blvd., 10 Civic Center Plaza, Santa Ana, CA 92701. With the completion of the County's new Administrative Complex, OC LAFCO will be moving their regular monthly meetings location -- starting in September 2022 -- to the County Administration South (CAS) Multipurpose Room, located at 601 N. Ross Street, Santa Ana, CA 92701.

OC LAFCO Info to Know – Acronym of the Quarter: "CKH"

- CKH stands for The [Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000](#) (The Act) which established procedures for local government reorganizations, including: city incorporations and disincorporations; special district formations and dissolutions; city and special district annexations, consolidations, detachments, and mergers; and, the establishment of subsidiary districts.
