- d. California Special Districts Association (CSDA) Report

CSDA Legislative Assistant Chris Palmer provided an update:

- Federal H.R. 7525: CSDA encourages its members to send letters of support to their Congress members for the Special District Grant Accessibility Act, which is a top priority. This bill would require the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to issue guidance to agencies, mandating the recognition of special districts as local governments for Federal financial assistance determinations. A template for the submission is available on the CSDA website.
