

The Special Districts Dialogue

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An update from your Special District Representatives on OC LAFCo



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Dear Honorable Special District Members: During the past quarter, the [Orange County Local Agency Formation Commission](#) (OC LAFCo, the Commission) held meetings on [May 13](#) and [June 10, 2026](#). OC LAFCo's next meeting is **Wednesday, August 12, 2026, starting at 8:15 a.m.**, in the County Administration North (CAN) First Floor Multipurpose Room 101, at 400 W. Civic Center Drive, Santa Ana, CA 92701. The Commission's recent items relevant to special districts include the following:

- [Activation of Latent Powers – Three Arch Bay Community Services District](#) – Following Commission approval at their March 11th meeting, TABCSD completed the LAFCO process—including the required protest hearing and final recordation—to activate its park and recreation powers. The District is now authorized to provide parks, beaches, recreational facilities, and related services directly to its community.
- [Alliance of LAFCOs](#) – Four Southern California LAFCOs (Los Angeles, Orange, San Bernardino, and San Diego) held their inaugural Alliance Workshop on March 24th to establish the organization's future direction. The members agreed to coordinate legislative advocacy, share best practices, and expand educational opportunities to create a stronger regional voice on issues affecting local government organization and service delivery.
- [Municipal Service Reviews \(MSRs\) Status](#) – The North Region MSR, covering five cities and the Placentia Library District and Yorba Linda Water District, is nearing completion and is anticipated to be presented to the Commission this summer. Work has also begun on the Coastal Region MSR, which includes five cities and eight special districts.
- [ISDOC Quarterly Meeting Schedule](#) – The Independent Special Districts of Orange County (ISDOC) will hold quarterly meetings on July 30 and October 29, 2026. Additional information is available at their website.
